- No power or generators available, or to be used.
- Limited cell phone coverage in area
- Stall operators must be self sufficient and take all rubbish away from site
- Stall operators staff will be given site access wrist bracelets to be worn
- Stall operators vehicles to be parked offsite at the lower YMCA Camp once you have finished off loading
- Festival organisers accept NO responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged products or belongings. You are responsible for your own security and cash/money.
- Cut off date for applications for stall site space November 30<sup>th</sup> 2018. Successful and unsuccessful stall operators will be advised.
