#### **Fiona Nicol:**

#### Speed Limit

- 71 responses to consultation process
- Majority of feedback most people want 50kms
- Looks like will be changed to 60kms (which is a good step) after all bureaucratic steps taken in Wellington NZTA
- Other options that were in the submissions will be addressed
- All submitters will be replied to
- A good positive step forward

**Tori Peden:** (dropped in briefly before meeting started)

• The Council land behind the shops is leased through until 2020

- Land between the recycling shed and the rail trail entrance is in fee simple owned by the CCC
- Water supply update for Little River residents will be available soon
- Community Board is looking into a 30000 tank for the fire brigade to draw from in Birdlings Flat or better access to water – perhaps accessing the holding tanks down Baileys Road
- Reserve Management committee is chasing up the tennis courts issue
- Discretionary Fund from CCC \$40000 available

## Projects to be considered

Magnet Bay/Tumbledown Bay Toilets:

Stuart Wright-Stow – there needs to be a wider debate than just getting toilets put there – an organisational group needs to lead that discussion

Suggestions that the Rod Donald Trust or the Banks Peninsula Committee be advocacy group involving Council, Rununga and Ecan

Little River Toilets

Suggested that the Trust apply for money from Government funds for Tourism and then approach Council for assistance to improve the toilets here at Little River.

Trust to explore funding, write to Council/Minister of Tourism

Various Board members expressed their interest in the below:

- Sculpture Park recreational area forest area, family walking trails, bike trails, education and environment sculpture, cultural garden - AE
- Dog Park another very popular idea AE/DM
- Board walks and bird hides around Lake Forsyth
- Sculpture in Little River
- Picnic tables, drinking fountain and a bigger playground (VM/AE) at the end of the rail trail
- Medical Centre this is a hot topic now since the article in the Press /Stuff
  yesterday with a lot of interest from the community DM/RB
- Water Sewerage Treatment system DM/RB
- Water Supply in Little River update coming soon from Council (Tori)

### Individual members of the Trust to pick up the projects that they are interested in

Stuart Wright-Stow suggested that we draw up a village plan that includes dog park, playground, sculpture all in one.

This has been done previously by Kathy Bisman – Robert to look for drawing

Fiona Nicol- good idea strategically. Develop a plan covering the above plus toilets for Little River – focus on this area

Janet Reeves keen to do more planning in this area

Working Party may morph into a smaller group – subset of the Trust – they are meeting this Thursday (3 February 2017)

\$14000 (?) in LRBI budget to spend on a project (some of this money is earmarked for printing of the LRBI plan booklet)
